MGP Cleaning and Maintenance







Cleaning

- Everyday stains or dirt can be cleaned with water and a stiff nylon brush or soft nylon scrubby. Use the minimum force required to remove the stain or debris, excess force can mar the surface texture.
- Stains that can not be removed with the method listed above can be soaked in bleach for removal. Do not use a 100% chlorine-based product.
- Grease and Oil stains can be removed with a citrus cleaner, alcohol, or mineral spirits. WD40° can be used as an alternative stain remover but will need to be wiped down with acetone and a non-dyed rag following application.
- Pressure washing is not recommended.
- The following products have successfully removed stains and marks; Goof Off®, Mr. Clean Magic Eraser®, GOJO® Orange pumice.
- Do not use MEK, turpentine or naphtha solvent.

Care and Maintenance

- Keep uncoated metals away from products. Rust stains are very difficult to remove especially on lighter colors.
- Tree sap and berries may permanently stain products. More frequent cleanings may be required if products are located under or near trees.
- Avoid contacting direct heat sources like lit cigarettes. Consistent heat exposure over 150-degrees Fahrenheit or more is not recommended.
- Paint will not adhere to MGP, and it is not recommended.
- This formulation of MGP is a scratch resistant, but it is not scratch or gouge proof.
